

**Main Features**

Students can be new or current LCC students. Full-time students earn their MTA (Michigan Transfer Agreement) Certificate in Transfer Studies in one year and the AA (Associate in Arts) Degree in Transfer Studies (with their selected major) in two years, while balancing life's many demands.<sup>1</sup>

Students attend in a cohort with other serious, committed college students and specialized committed Program Faculty.

In Year 1, students complete the Michigan Transfer Certificate containing all general education requirements transferable to their intended transfer institution. Specialized faculty teach classes in this program where the curriculum is interconnected for a unique, personalized overall learning experience similar to that of a small, liberal arts college, but with the price-tag of a community college.

In Year 2, students complete a quality Associates in Arts Degree in Transfer Studies (in their selected major) for transfer to their intended 4-year transfer institution.

Time on campus is minimized while retaining the importance of face-to-face or in-person interaction. Classes meet on main campus one night a week and every other Saturday.

Students meet with a Program Specialist Academic Advisor to assure that 100% of all their LCC credit transfers to their 4- year college of choice.

Students receive specialized advising on approaches to career-context self-study, self-reflection, and approaches to career choice.

Students should plan on transferring to their selected 4-year institution with junior standing, having saved significant time and money.


**Get the in-person instruction and interaction you need to be successful** – Have the ability to meet with your professor and collaborate with other serious, committed students in this selective admissions program.
